Dr. Panza completed his residency in internal medicine and cardiology at the Italian Hospital, Buenos Aires, and held a Clinical Research Fellowship in the Cardiology Branch of the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute, in Bethesda, Maryland. He is a graduate of the School of Medical Sciences at the National University of Rosario, Argentina.
