## Dr. Eduardo F. Mele, MD, PhD, FACC, FSIAC, FESC

Dr. Mele is the current Governor of the Argentina Chapter of the American College of Cardiology. He is a Professor of Medicine for the University of Buenos Aires, with special focus on postgraduate teaching, and serves as Staff Physician for the Cardiology Division at Sanatorio Güemes, Buenos Aires. Mele is a Member of the Academic Committee of the Cardiology Postgraduate Program and Vice Director of the same program at Sanatorio Güemes Teaching Unit.

For the last 30 years, Dr. Mele has been an active participant in the Argentine Society of Cardiology, serving in several roles and becoming President in 2008; he now serves on the Advisory Board of Past Presidents. Dr. Mele is board certified in Cardiology and received his medical doctorate from the University of Buenos Aires. He completed his residency in Cardiology at the Alvear Hospital in Buenos Aires and has served as Staff Physician of the Coronary Care Unit and Cardiology Division at the University Hospital of the University of Buenos Aires.

Dr. Mele is a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology, a Fellow of the European Society of Cardiology and a Fellow of the Interamerican Society of Cardiology, and in 2013 he chaired the Organizing Committee of the 24th Interamerican Congress of Cardiology. He has authored or co-authored 40+ papers published in national and international journals. His field of interest is ischaemic heart disease, acute and chronic.
