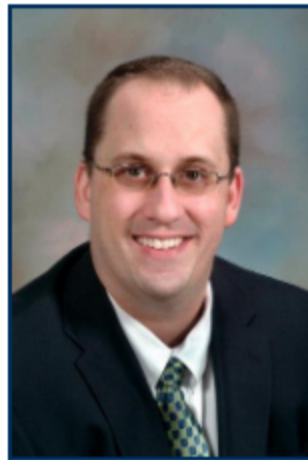


## President's Column
