Valentin Fuster, MD, PhD, MACC, is the Director of Mount Sinai Heart and Physician-in-Chief of The Mount Sinai Hospital, and he is currently Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of the American College of Cardiology. The innumerable positions Dr. Fuster has held include those of President of the American Heart Association (AHA); President of the World Heart Federation; member of the US National Academy of Medicine, where he chaired the Committee for the document on "Promotion of Cardiovascular Health Worldwide and presently Co-Chairs the Advisory Committee on "the Role of the United States on Global Health" as advisor to the President; Member of the European Horizon 2020 Scientific Panel of Health; Council member of the US National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute; and President of the Training Program of the ACC.

Dr. Fuster's research is unparalleled in areas relating to the causes, prevention, and treatment of cardiovascular disease globally, and spans the full range from hardcore basic science and molecular biology, through clinical studies and large-scale multinational trials to population sciences and global medicine. Among his many achievements, Dr. Fuster is the only cardiologist to have received the highest awards for research from the four leading cardiovascular organizations: the ACC, the AHA, the European Society of Cardiology, and the Interamerican Society of Cardiology.
